Kebo Members,

I'm sure that many of you are aware of the remodel of the Men's Bathroom and Lounge completed in 2011. We are now considering a Phase 2 of this project, which would include a remodel of the Men's Locker Room in 2012. We are very interested in feedback from all of the membership on this possible project. If there is sufficient interest, we are considering replacing the current metal lockers with custom made hardwood lockers. As you might suspect, the hardwood (birch & mahogany) lockers are not cheap. We would need a commitment from several of the members to go forward on this project, as the Club does not have discretionary funds during these difficult economic times. One half of the Locker Room floor has been tiled, as part of the 2011 Bathroom and Lounge project. We would utilize this half for the proposed Locker Room project. Some finishing of the existing cement walls would also be done during this project. The other half of the Locker Room would remain unfinished, and used for possible future expansion. The new lockers would be approximately the same size as the current metal lockers. We would offer the full size lockers, as well as the half size lockers. Approximately 20 years ago, Kebo offered a "Locker for Life" program. We are looking to bring that promotion back, and would propose offering these at \$1000 for a full size locker, or \$500 for a half size locker. Members participating in the "Locker for Life" program would have an attractive plaque identifying their locker. Those interested in a shorter term commitment, could rent a full size locker for \$100/yr., or a half size locker for \$50/yr.. As part of the effort to enhance the appearance of the Locker Room, we are considering not allowing push/pull cart storage in, or on top of, the new lockers. This would require a separate area for cart storage for those interested. We have a few ideas in mind to accommodate those folks, and any storage fee would be included in the prices discussed earlier. If we have sufficient interest and commitment by 1/1/12 to fund the project, we'll go ahead, with a completion date prior to the Spring opening of Kebo. Please respond to this e-mail with any questions, concerns, or suggestions that you might have.
